1. General Product Information

1.1 What is AutoCAD 2012 software?

You can design and shape the world around you with the powerful, flexible features in AutoCAD software, one of the world's leading 2D and 3D design software products. New and expanded workflows for model documentation, reality capture and 3D conceptual design help to increase productivity with AutoCAD 2012. Explore your design ideas with powerful surface modelling tools. Quickly create documents from a variety of modelling formats, helping to reduce manual documentation workarounds. Capture and import as-built information to jumpstart your design process. You'll also find a wide range of timesaving enhancements to the features you use most. AutoCAD 2012 delivers the powerful tools you need to participate in smooth 3D design workflows, helping drive your projects to completion quicker than ever before.

1.2 Who uses AutoCAD software?

AutoCAD software is used by architects, CAD technicians, designers, engineers, project managers and CAD/IT managers in a variety of industries, including the manufacturing, building, civil and mapping industries.

For example, AutoCAD is used by:

- Design professionals who create conceptual designs, exploring ideas in 3D models.
- Design professionals who create technical drawings.
- Drafters who put the finishing touches on a design with detailing, annotations, links to online data and verification of accuracy.

2.4 What product downloads are available for AutoCAD Subscription members?

Product downloads may include the latest release of the software that becomes available during your subscription term, extensions or bonus packs that become available during your subscription term or other rich content for AutoCAD software. These enhancements are exclusive to Subscription members and can be downloaded from the Subscription Centre at www.autodesk.co.uk/subscriptionlogin

3. Compatibility and Interoperability

3.1 Do third-party applications based on previous versions of AutoCAD software work with AutoCAD 2012 software?

Maybe. If third-party add-on applications were created or updated for AutoCAD 2010 or AutoCAD 2011, they should work fine with AutoCAD 2012 software. Third-party applications built for previous versions of AutoCAD and based on ActiveX[®] and ObjectARX[®] developer tools may require upgrades to be compatible with AutoCAD 2012. Check with your application developer/supplier regarding availability of applications built for AutoCAD 2012.

3.2 Do AutoCAD 2011 customised menus work in AutoCAD 2012 software?

Yes, AutoCAD 2012 software automatically migrates customised menus (CUI files). The first time you launch AutoCAD 2012, the migration feature asks you if you would like to migrate the settings from your previous AutoCAD version to AutoCAD 2012. The migration feature helps you make a smooth transition to the new release by automatically migrating customised menus, toolbar icons, hatch patterns, linetypes, command shortcuts and profiles. 3.3 Has the AutoCAD 2012 DWG file format changed from the AutoCAD 2011 product?

No, the AutoCAD 2012 DWG file format has not been updated and is no different from the 2011 DWG file format.

3.4 Does AutoCAD 2012 software read and save drawings created by earlier releases of AutoCAD?

AutoCAD 2012 reads drawing files from all previous versions of AutoCAD software. AutoCAD 2012 has a built-in Save As function, so you can save drawings to and from AutoCAD releases using the AutoCAD Release 14, 2000, 2004 and 2007 DWG formats. In addition, you can use the Save As AutoCAD Release 12 DXF™ command to support releases prior to AutoCAD Release 14.

3.5 Can I open an AutoCAD 2012 drawing with an older release of AutoCAD?

You can open an AutoCAD 2012 drawing using AutoCAD 2010 and AutoCAD 2011. To open drawings with previous versions, you should use DWG TrueView™ software to translate DWG files to AutoCAD Release 14, 2000, 2004 and 2007 file formats. DWG TrueView can be downloaded at www.autodesk.co.uk/dwgtrueview. DWG TrueView does not require the AutoCAD application in order to convert DWG files.

3.6 Can I run AutoCAD 2012 side-by-side with other AutoCAD platform-based applications?

Yes, AutoCAD 2012 can be installed side-by-side with any other AutoCAD[®] or Autodesk[®] vertical solution, including AutoCAD 2012-based products.

3.7 Is AutoCAD 2012 compatible with AutoCAD LT?

Yes, AutoCAD 2012 is fully DWG-compatible with AutoCAD LT[®] 2012 software. It can read files from all older versions of AutoCAD LT and can save to the AutoCAD 2007, 2004, 2000 and Release 14 DWG file formats for compatibility with older products.

4. Platform and System Requirements

4.1 What are the system requirements for AutoCAD 2012 software?

4.2 Does AutoCAD 2012 software support 64-bit operating systems?

Yes. See the system requirements above.

4.3 Does AutoCAD 2012 software support multiple CPU systems?

Yes, AutoCAD 2012 software supports multiple CPUs. The performance of AutoCAD graphics and rendering systems benefits from multiple CPU systems.

5. Licensing

5.1 Does AutoCAD 2012 software use product activation for stand-alone licences?

Yes, with AutoCAD 2012 software the authorisation process includes product activation.

5.2 What is product activation?

Product activation is a software-based licence management technology incorporated into many Autodesk products. It is a secure and trouble-free process that authenticates licensed users running Autodesk software. The process verifies that the serial number is legitimate and is activated only on eligible computers. It does not affect the ability of licensed users to operate their software the way they have always done. It is similar to the authorisation mechanism used in Autodesk products in the past but provides additional capabilities for security and special product versions (such as student and trial versions).

5.3 Why does Autodesk require Autodesk customers to activate their software?

Product activation is a simple way to reduce and deter unauthorised use and casual copying of Autodesk products with little to no impact on loyal customers.

5.4 How do I activate my software?

Through the activation and registration interface, you can activate your product 24 hours a day, seven days a week, on the Internet or via email. Either option takes only a few steps to complete and requires your product serial number and registration information.

5.5 What if I have more than one computer? Will product activation allow me to use the software on multiple machines?

Autodesk recognises that some users may need to operate the software when they are away from their usual work location. To accommodate this need, the product activation technology allows an employee to install the software on a second computer owned by the employee's company, provided it is for use away from the employee's usual work location. The software is used only by that employee and no other and only one of the two copies of the software is ever in use at any one time. Consult the Autodesk Software Licence Agreement for details about using the software on a second computer.

5.6 How do I transfer my software licence to another machine?

The Online Licence Transfer (OLT) Utility allows licences to be moved between machines. The OLT replaces the former Portable Licence Utility. To transfer a licence, simply start the transfer utility and choose Export. Then log in to the OLT website and "park" your licence at an Autodesk "parking area." At the destination computer, start the transfer utility and choose Import. Log back in to the OLT website and import your licence to the destination computer.

Check the Autodesk Exchange window to see if an update is available. AutoCAD 2012 recognises if you have the most up-to-date release and prompts you if there is an update available. When you click the link, AutoCAD 2012 automatically downloads and installs the update.
